### **Emergency Management Petition – UPDATE:**

Summary: All prisoners in Victoria are entitled to up to 4 days off their sentences for every day or part day they are inconvenienced by emergencies or industrial disputes in prisons. Over 1000 years was taken off prison sentences over the covid period in Victoria. Boyd, along with his daughter Bianca, are petitioning for this 1990s legislation to be debated in Parliament and ultimately revoked.

Message from Judy Unwin: "Our family would like to thank everyone who signed the petition and those who took sheets to get more signatures. It was very much appreciated. Boyd took the petitions to Renee Heath at Parliament. Renee presented 2,855 written signatures and 3,750 online signatures to Parliament. It was agreed that the legislation would be debated in Parliament. This was to have been on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> November and Boyd and Bianca were invited to be there. On Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November Boyd was advised that it would not be debated on that day and would be deferred!! We just hope that when the legislation is debated, changes will be made. Thank you again – Judy Unwin."

- CDs and DVDs (and plastic cases)
- all coffee/Slurpee cups, plastic straws and lids – or take to 7-Eleven in Gap Road
- used postage stamps Joycelyn and Reg collect for Sammy Stamp
- toner/ink cartridges, batteries, small electrical devices
- mobile phones and chargers, to support Melbourne Zoo's 'Gorilla Doctors' program in East Africa
