Sunbury Police Community Register

The Sunbury Police Community Register is a register of a person's contact and medical information, plus contact information of the next-of-kin, which can be used by approved authorities in emergencies – Police, Ambulance, Hospital and Fire Brigade. The details will be entered in a confidential database at the Sunbury Police Station. The aim of the register is for a member at Sunbury Police Station to make regular phone calls to, and provide reassurance and

wellbeing checks for – the frail, aged and those living with disability or who are socially isolated. If no contact is able to be made, the police member then contacts the next-of-kin listed on the register.

If you know of anyone who could benefit from being on this register, you'll find application forms in the pamphlet rack in the Link, or you can attend Sunbury Police Station in person. The motto of the register is "Know that somebody knows you're there!"



Recycling Corner

Use the recycling trolley in the foyer for donations of the following:
