Bereavement (belated notice due to no newsletter last Sunday). Some of our older members will remember Joan Millar from the Bulla congregation. Joan passed away on the 14<sup>th</sup> October, aged 98. I received the following information from another dear friend and long-term Bulla member, Anita Tozer (now living in Qld), who said: "Joan was 98 when she passed away and has lived most successfully by herself since the death of her sister Mavis a few years ago. Her home is a beautiful heritage-listed home of about 175 years, on a 250 acre property, with thousands of years-old red gums. Joan was ill for only 24 hours thankfully, and passed away most peacefully in St. Vincent's Hospital. Joan had a strong church connection all her life, following in the footsteps of her family."
